What is the FBISDCAAA Victim Assistance Project?

FBI Victim Specialists work with a network of local non-profits and other service providers to help victims and their families cope with the impact of trauma resulting from violent crimes, crimes against children, human trafficking, hate crimes, white collar and cyber crimes. While there are a variety of worthy programs dedicated to supporting victims of these crimes, there is often a gap in scope and time when these resources or services are not immediately available. The FBISDCAAA Victim Assistance Project is intended to bridge this gap and provide discretionary funding and services to help meet the critical needs of victims and reduce the effects of trauma.

How will my donation be used?

Contributions to the **FBISDCAAA** Victim Assistance Project will address victim needs, which may include:

- Clothes for a rape victim when investigators must collect their clothes for DNA testing
- Suitcases for victims of human trafficking who have nothing but a trash bag to carry their belongings
- Lodging and transportation for individuals and families fleeing violent situations
- Dental or medical procedures for victims of torture and abuse
- Meals for a community or congregation victimized by a hate crime

Donations help **provide immediate relief** for victims during interviews, court hearings, forensic examinations, and other stressful situations.
